

### COURSES OFFERED TO INCOMING STUDENTS

Most courses at MSB are taught in German due to state regulations in the field of Psychotherapy and Human Medicine. For courses at the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Health Sciences you must have proof of language proficiency in German level B2 (CEFR) upon arrival (B1 upon application accepted).

At the Faculty of Medicine, German language skills at level C1 (CEFR) are required.

The graduate study program Digital Health Management is fully taught in English. In this case you need to present a certificate proving an English level of B2 (CEFR).

### EXAMS, GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS

### TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

The Incoming students and their institution will receive an official transcript of records electronically after the semester. This document will contain all courses and exam results at MSB Medical School Berlin.

### **EXAMS AND GRADING SYSTEM**

The final exams take place during the examination period at the end of each semester.

Students successfully pass the course if they receive a 4,0 and higher.

MSB Medical School Berlin uses the following grading system:

## VISA & HEALTH INSURANCE

Non-EU/EEA citizens must apply for a visa for university studies before their departure to Germany. Further information is provided by the German Embassy or Consulate in your home country.

A visa application costs approximately 60€ and may take one to three months to be processed.

### **HEALTH INSURANCE**

Every person living in Germany is required to have a health insurance. For the enrolment you have to provide a proof of sufficient health insurance coverage.
